Evaluation Methods Used:

Testing with assistive technologies

The information contained within this Voluntary Product Accessibility Template (VPAT) is a result of an audit performed by an independent contractor, <u>Sarah Ferguson</u> during July-October, 2019. This assessment fully tested the compliance of the web-based LMS software with the WCAG 2.0 A and AA and Section 508 standards. This audit included, but was not limited to: automated testing with multiple accessibility tools such as aXe and Site Improve, as well as manual testing with leading assistive technologies such as JAWS screen reader, VoiceOver screen reader, Windows Magnifier screen magnification software and keyboard-only navigation. The following tools within Sakai 19 were extensively tested: the overall interface or "Portal," the "Tests and Quizzes" component, the Gradebook, the Rubrics tool and the Profile interface.

An additional representative sample test was performed by Akea Web Solutions to define the existing state of accessibility as of 2021. This updates based on WCAG 2.1 Guidelines
